New Delhi, the 18th August, 2009

**G.S.R. 122.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution and in partial supersession of the Directorate of Printing, Government of India Stationery Office and Department of Publications (Class I and Class II Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1963 in so far as they relate to the post of Controller of Stationery, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Controller of Stationery, in the Government of India Stationery Office in the Ministry of Urban Development, namely :—

**1. Short title and commencement.**—(1) These rules may be called the Government of India Stationery Office, (Controller of Stationery) Recruitment Rules, 2009.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

**2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.**—The number of said post, its classification and the Pay Band and Grade Pay/Pay Scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

**3. Method of recruitment, age-limit and other qualifications, etc.**—The method of recruitment to the said post, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the said Schedule.

**4. Disqualification.**—No person,—

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

**5. Power to relax.**—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

**6. Saving.**—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen, Other Backward Classes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Promotion falling which by deputation (including short term contract).	<p><b>Promotion :</b> Deputy Controller of Stationery and Deputy Controller of Inspection in the Pay Band-3 Rs.15,600-39,100 Grade Pay Rs. 6600 with five years' regular service in the grade.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade alongwith their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.</p> <p><b>Deputation (including short-term contract):</b></p> <p>Officers under the Central Government or State Governments or Union Territories or Public Sector Undertakings or Autonomous or Semi-Autonomous Bodies;</p> <p>(a) (i) holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre or Department; or</p> <p>(ii) with five years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the Pay Band-3 Rs. 15600-39100 Grade Pay Rs. 6600 or equivalent in the parent cadre or Department ; and</p>

(b) Possessing the following educational qualifications and experience:—

(i) Graduate Degree from a recognised University or equivalent; and

(ii) possessing ten years experience in the field of Stationery and Stores.

**Note :** The Departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation.

Similarly deputationist shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

[Period of deputation (including short term contract) including period of deputation (including short term contract) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organization or Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed four years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (including short term contract) shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of the receipt of applications].

**Group 'A' Departmental Promotion Committee (for considering promotion)**

1. **Chairman**—Chairman or Member of Union Public Service Commission.
2. **Member**—Joint Secretary in-charge of Government of India Stationery Office, Ministry of Urban Development.
3. **Member**—Joint Secretary and Financial Adviser, Ministry of Urban Development.
